5. A brief summary of research activities and why they must be done on site.

The research that will be undertaken is laboratory based and must be performed in properly designed laboratory spaces for safety and access to necessary equipment, both of which are only available on site. 6. Summary of precautions and standard operating procedures that must be followed to safely conduct the above research activities in the spaces listed and with maintenance of social distancing.

In addition to the university and department level precautions, the on-site work will include the following precautions specific to the spaces described:

The Lab Coordinators listed above will prepare electronic calendars accessible to individual graduate students and post docs to coordinate experimental (research) plans and to ensure that a buddy system is maintained. Coordinators will also prepare a form consistent with Departmental guideline 4 to monitor laboratory PPE levels and facilitate acquisition of necessary items such as gloves, masks, and ethanol solutions. Finally, the Coordinators will prepare an online log sheet to document hourly lab work and to communicate questions between the lab, Coordinators, and PI.

All lab members will be required to comply with the established Departmental Guidelines toward hygiene and personal safety. In addition, in order to maintain social distancing, researchers will be required to use separate lab benches, minimize time in research offices, and plan with other members will not use the same instrument simultaneously.
